

Myanmar Earthquake YMCA Emergency Relief Fund

A magnitude 7.7 earthquake struck central Myanmar on March 28, 2025, causing significant damage across the country. The city of Mandalay, which has been reported to be severely affected, is home to the Mandalay YMCA, a partner organization of Osaka YMCA. We have received information that they are conducting relief activities and assessing the damage to their buildings. Myanmar students attending the Osaka YMCA Japanese language school have also reported that their families have been affected by the disaster.

Specific details of the relief activities will be planned in collaboration with Myanmar YMCA, Mandalay YMCA, and the Japan YMCA Alliance. However, to begin relief efforts immediately, we kindly request your cooperation in supporting the emergency relief fund.
